



Enrollment and Materials Fact Sheet

In order to participate at any level of the 2010 Spelling Bee, each school must become officially enrolled with the Scripps National Spelling Bee. Enrollment will begin on Monday, August 17, 2009, and continue through Thursday, October 15 on the Scripps National website, www.spellingbee.com.

Enrollment and Materials Fee

The materials and enrollment fee for the 2010 Scripps National Spelling Bee program is \$99 per participating school (public, private, parochial, charter, and online/virtual school) and home school association. The fee for an individual home school family who is not part of a home school association is \$10.

- Fees must be paid for by credit card only
- Scripps accepts the following credit cards: Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express
- Checks, money orders and purchase orders are not accepted

Study Materials

In exchange for the fee, schools receive unlimited online access to all of Scripps' study materials:

- Merriam-Webster, Spell It!, the official study booklet
- Three grade-specific versions of the Classroom Pronouncer Guide
- The School Pronouncer Guide

Scripps will mail 25 *Spell It!* study booklets to each enrolled school.

Registration for The Dallas Morning News Regional Spelling Bee

The Dallas Morning News will not register schools as we have in the past. Instead, enrollment at the Scripps website, www.spellingbee.com, will serve as our registration. After the October 15, 2009 enrollment deadline, Scripps will send *The Dallas Morning News* a list of all schools and home schools participating in our 38-county region. Therefore, it is especially important that you register before the deadline. There will be no late enrollment for The Dallas Morning News Region on the Scripps website.
